




Cut out the word and definition cards and mix them up. Can you match the word with its definition?






This means that you prefer something or are against something in a way that is unfair.



A thought or belief about a person or a thing. These are sometimes based on facts but can also be influenced by feelings, attitudes or values.




Someone or something that supplies information. Some are reliable and trustworthy, some of them are not.



Something that is known to have happened or to exist, especially something that can be proven. It is something that is true.





A news story or website on the internet that is designed to attract attention. The content of the story often doesn't match the headline.



Inventing a story or a piece of information that is false. There are lots of reasons why people might do this but it can cause the reader to believes something that isn't true.



To show all of the circumstances around an event, statement or idea so that it can be completely understood.



To make sure that something is true by checking the facts, finding out who wrote it and why, or asking a responsible person for advice.



Not completely correct or exact. Some people post this sort of information on the internet to mislead the reader.

Hidden agenda

If something has quickly become very popular or well known by being published on the internet or sent from person to person by email, phone or on social media.


Go viral

If someone has this then they have a secret aim or reason for doing something. It is good to remember that sometimes there is a secret reason for the things we see on the internet.





Examining something very carefully so that you can discover more information about it. This often means checking facts and trying to spot when someone is presenting opinions as facts.



A news story, website or piece of information is able to be believed or trusted.



If someone has this then they will interpret and understand new information (like a news story or a fact) in a way which supports what they already think. This can mean that they ignore information that doesn't agree with their opinions.


Confirmation Bias This means that something's true meaning has been changed. This is often so that it can support someone's hidden agenda or bias.




This means that something has been created by someone who wants to keep their name a secret.



A plan to deceive someone. This could be in an attempt to trick them for fun or they could have an unkind or sinister reason. The internet is often used to share hoaxes and these can have unfortunate consequences.









